

Lane Line Numbers for Gold PRO and Gold Racing Lane Lines

Lane Line Numbers for 8 or 10 competition racing lanes, approved by Fina and LEN. The double-sided numbers are mounted on the racing lane line and make it easy for judges, officials and the public to identify the different lanes. They are made of soft foam material that cannot cause damage to the swimmer, and have a weight underneath, so the sign always stands straight up. Easy to remove the numbers after the competition. The weights can remain attached when rolling up the racing lanes.


For competitions 8 lanes- 18 double-sided lane line numbers are needed for 9 lane lines: $2 \times 8 = 12, 2 \times 1/2, 2 \times 2/3, 2 \times 3/4, 2 \times 4/5, 2 \times 5/6, 2 \times 6/7, 2 \times 7/8, 2 \times 8/8 = 8$

For competitions 10 lanes-22 double-sided lane line numbers are needed for 11 lane lines: 2×8 Blank side/0, $2 \times 0/1$, $2 \times 1/2$, $2 \times 2/3$, $2 \times 3/4$, $2 \times 4/5$, $2 \times 5/6$, $2 \times 6/7$, $2 \times 7/8$, $2 \times 8/9$, $2 \times 9/8$ Blank side.

Sold per unit.

The sign is to be assembled according to the attached sample. The lane line number must be mounted out towards the pool. Everything should be assembled on the 15th disc from the wall for Gold PRO Racing Lane Line and 17th for Gold Racing Lane Line.


15th disc for Gold PRO and 17th for Gold




